Dear Mr. Wing:

This letter is intended to formally notify EPA Region II that the Department of Energy (DOE) plans to undertake a removal action at the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) site in Maywood, New Jersey. This notification is provided in accordance with the requirements of the draft Federal Facility Agreement for the site.

The removal action is anticipated to begin in June 1991 and take approximately two months to complete. The goal of the removal action is to remove the radioactive contamination from the property at 90 Avenue C in Lodi. This action is being classified as an time-critical removal since the contamination is present in the structural materials of the residence, the residence is occupied by a family with three children, and the radiation dose rates in the kitchen exceed DOE's radiation protection standard of 100 mrem/yr for the general public under some occupancy scenarios.
