> On June 9, 1992 Jeff Gratz and I conducted our bi-monthly project managers meeting, in accordance with Section XIV.E of the FFA, via telephone for the Maywood and Wayne sites. Topics discussed during the telephone call included the following. (1) Releasing Maywood RI data to the Stepan Company. EPA would like to send some RI analytical data to Stepan to add support for an EPA request of additional work (to be conducted by Stepan). I agreed to discuss this request with my management and will respond within the week; initial reaction is that there is no problem, providing certain precautions are taken. (2) Status of Maywood RI/FS documentation and Wayne workplan addendum. Schedules were reviewed and progress discussed. EPA indicated that they have some concerns with the Maywood BRA (e.g., ecological risk assessment and COC's). (3) Status of Wayne RI data. DOE and EPA agreed that rather than sending the raw data with the quarterly report, EPA will wait to receive summary tables, when they are available.
