On 12/18/92, representatives from DOE and EPA met in Region II to discuss the preferred remedy for Maywood. Jeff Gratz and I agreed that this meeting would meet the requirements of the bi-monthly project manager's meeting. Several items were raised during this meeting including:

- 1. Prior to release of the Proposed Plan, DOE should investigate the viability of Maywood waste disposal at a DOE site;
- 2. DOE should assess now, rather than after the ROD, the potential exposure to employees working where contamination is proposed to be left in place; and
- 3. DOE should consider issuing a single ROD for Maywood while still allowing phased implementation of the selected remedy (i.e.; identify now the remedy for future phases with contingencies in place).
