In accordance with Section XIV.G.6 of the Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA) for the Maywood site, this letter shall serve as notice that DOE is extending the schedule for delivery of the draft final FS-EIS and Proposed Plan by an additional twenty days per the terms outlined in the FFA.

DOE is aggressively pursuing delivery of this document within the original 60-day schedule, which would require delivery to EPA by April 2, 1993. However, in order to effective y address groundwater in the next draft of these documents, as requested by EPA, additional time may be necessary. If the additional 20 days is utilized, delivery to EPA would be necessary by April 22, 1993.
