FOR THE MAYWOOD SITE, MAYWOOD, NEW JERSEY and FOR THE REMOVAL ACTION AT ONE PROPERTY IN LODI, NEW JERSEY

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) announces the availability for public review of files constituting the administrative record for the selection of a remedial action to clean up contamination present at the Maywood Site, Maywood, New Jersey, and for the removal action at one property in Lodi, New Jersey. The site is part of DOE's Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP). DOE established FUSP, AP to identify and cleanup or control sites where radioactive contamination (exceeding current guidelines) remains from the early years of the nation's atomic energy programs or from commercial operations that Congress has authorized DOE to clean up. DOE seeks to inform the public of the availability of the administrative record file at the Maywood Public Library and to encourage the public to comment on documents as they are placed in the record file.

The administrative record file includes documents that form the basis for the selection of a remedial action alternative for the Maywood Site. Documents now in the administrative record file include the preliminary assessment and site investigation reports, as well as reports on work that has previously been conducted at the site. Other documents will be added to the administrative record as work at the site progresses. These additional documents may include, but are not limited to, the work plan, the remedial investigation/feasibility study report, other technical reports, the community relations plan, comments and new data submitted by interested persons, and DOE responses to significant comments.
