MAYWOOD AND WAYNE SITES -- REQUEST FOR INFORMATION REGARDING ENTERING INTO THE FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENTS

As stated in your letter of November 7, 1994 to Mr. Les Price (DOE), and in subsequent phone conversations, you have indicated that NJDEP is interested in exploring it's options for entering into the Federal Facility Agreements (FFA) for the Maywood and Wayne sites. As I understand it, one of the primary reasons for exploring this option is to secure funding for oversight activities conducted by NJDEP for these sites.
