Dear Mr. Nolan:

This is in response to your fax of March 4, 1995 regarding Dr. Resnikoff's memorandum to you (dated February 20, 1995). In speaking with Dr. Resnikoff at another meeting on March 15, 1995 Dr. Resnikoff indicated that he and representatives of the Department of Energy are discussing this memo and the need for additional thoron testing directly. In light of this further intervention by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is not required at this time.

With respect to the 15 pCi/g criterion established for commercial use at the Maywood Site, evaluation by both EPA and DOE have determined this level to be protective under commercial use conditions. Pursuant to CERCLA \$121(c) and the Federal Facility Agreement, following successful remediation, the Maywood site will be subject to 5-year reviews to assure that human health and the environment remain protected by the remedial action being implemented. Should future land use change (e.g. to residential) then this would be evaluated further.
