At the request of the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and with your consent, Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL) performed a radiological survey of your property at 1 Shady Lane in Lodi. I have received the radiological survey report, which I am forwarding for your information and use.

The radiation levels measured during the survey were similar to the background levels in the Maywood area. Four soil samples were taken for analysis, and all four exhibited background concentrations of radioactive elements. No materials that are attributable to the former Maywood Chemical operation were identified. Based on the results of the survey, DOE will eliminate your property from further consideration in the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program.
