## Important News for All Interested Parties

### FINAL CLEANUP PLAN PROPOSED FOR THE MAYWOOD SITE

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New York District, will conduct a public meeting on August 28, 2002, in Trinka Hall at the Maywood Borough Hall (lower level), 459 Maywood Avenue, Maywood, New Jersey to present its proposed cleanup plan for radioactively contaminated soil and buildings at the Maywood Interim Storage Site and vicinity site properties. You are invited to hear how the proposal was developed and comment on the plan. The meeting will be from 6 to 9 p.m.

The preferred cleanup remedy for the Maywood Site is excavation, treatment to reduce the volume of soil requiring disposal as radioactive waste, and offsite disposal. This alternative is believed to provide the best balance among the alternatives evaluated for the site. Other alternatives evaluated included: no action (evaluation is required); monitoring and institutional controls, and; excavation and offsite disposal.

The public comment period on the Proposed Plan runs from August 14 to September 12, 2002. Interested parties are invited to the public meeting to learn more about the alternatives developed for this site. The meeting is also an opportunity to submit comments on the Proposed Plan.

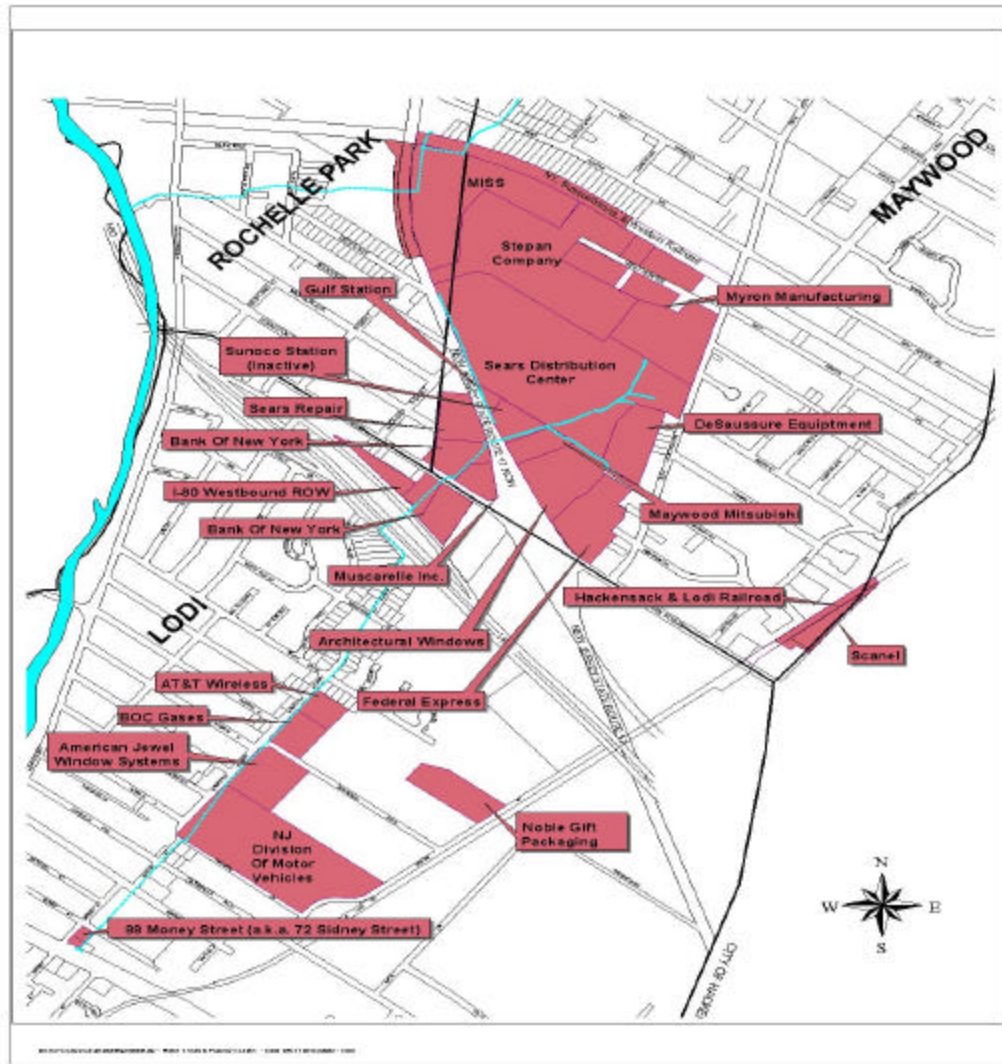

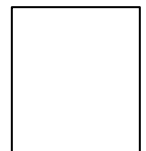
