The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), Oak Ridge Field Office, is pleased to announce the opening of a public information center at 43 West Pleasant Avenue in Maywood. The information center, scheduled to open April 13, 1992, has been established to provide locally available information about the thorium cleanup project at the Maywood Site.

The Maywood Site is made up of various residential, commercial, state, municipal, and federal properties in Maywood, Rochelle Park, and Lodi that are contaminated with low levels of radioactive thorium. Congress authorized cleanup of the Maywood Site under the DOE Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP). Susan Cange is the DOE Site Manager responsible for implementing activities at the Maywood Site.

The DOE Public Information Center will enable callers and visitors to ask questions and make comments concerning the Maywood Site, which will help DOE in understanding the issues and concerns of the local communities. The public will be given opportunities to review and comment on proposed cleanup alternatives prior to final selection.

Background information on the Maywood Site is available in the information repository and administrative record file located at both the Maywood Public Library and the DOE Public Information Center.
