On 10/8/92, Jeff Gratz and I held our bi-monthly project manager's meeting via telephone. The following topics were discussed:


I. Maywood

- A. Radon in homes - Jeff will be sending a letter suggesting that DOE test for Radon in homes where we do not have any data.
- B. 20-day unilateral extension - Jeff indicated that this extension is only for the draft final of a document and not the first draft. DOE could therefore not use this extension for the formal submittal of the FS-EIS.
- C. Number of copies of the draft final RI report to be sent to EPA and Alliance -
- D. Results of drum consolidation effort in Building 76 and DOE's plans to provide a tour of Building 76 to local officials.
- E. DOE's plans to collect soil samples from the Maywood Municipal pool grounds.

II. Wayne

- A. Wayne RI summary tables - Jeff requested the RI summary tables be sent ASAP. He also requested a copy of the data collected at PPRS that we will be sending to ATSDR.
- B. DOE's offer to cleanup VP's and consolidate material at WISS - we discussed Mayor Miller's rejection of this offer and his suggestion to blend the contaminated soil with clean soil and to use it as road fill.
