MAYWOOD SITE - FALL 1995 CLEANUP OF LODI VICINITY PROPERTIES


This letter is to clarify questions which have arisen regarding the Department of Energy's (DOE) plans for cleanup of three Lodi residential properties during the Fall of 1995. DOE anticipates approximately 150 cubic yards of excavated material to be generated from these properties. Our Fall 1995 cleanup effort is limited to these three Lodi residential properties.

To address community concerns regarding the Fall 1995 Lodi properties cleanup, DOE has agreed to incorporate the following into our cleanup plans. Arrangements for railroad gondola cars to be present at the Maywood Interim Storage Site (MISS) will be made prior to the commencement of cleanup of these three Lodi properties. During the Fall 1995 cleanup, no excavated material shall be brought to MISS until the gondola railcar is available. Excavated material will be deposited upon a lined transfer location for loading onto gondolas. Although it is anticipated that excavated material will be loaded onto a gondola prior to the end of each workday during the Fall 1995 cleanup, all excavated material shall be loaded within 48 hours after the deposit at MISS. All excavated material from the three Lodi properties, which is present at MISS or in gondolas, shall be properly covered to prevent dispersal.

The transport of all excavated material to MISS shall be in accordance with the route set forth in the letter from Bechtel to Joe Dominic dated September 18, 1995. All vehicles shall be properly covered to prevent dispersal en route.
