Thank you for your letter of June 13, 1991. The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is pleased to hear that DOE is planning to remediate New Jersey's FUSRAP sites in the near future. To date, New Jersey's involvement in FUSRAP sites has been limited to an oversight capacity, although we have reviewed various remedial plans and data and attended meetings concerning these sites.

Concerning future involvement, the Department would like the opportunity to review all analytical, remedial and disposal plans. We feel that our involvement is critical to this process. We also feel that it is imperative to be involved in all site related meetings. Please copy Karl Delaney, Director, Division of Responsible Party Site Remediation, 401 East State Street, Fifth Floor, CN-028, Trenton, New Jersey 08625, on all correspondence and inform us of all meetings concerning these sites. This is particularly important because of the level of public involvement.

The Department regularly receives letters of inquiry concerning these sites and in many cases the public is extremely upset with the apparent lack of progress concerning the disposal of stored wastes. If we are not involved in DOE's process, then the Department cannot adequately respond to the citizens of the state of New Jersey.

Once again, thank you for your letter and I look forward to working with you towards a timely resolution of these sites.
