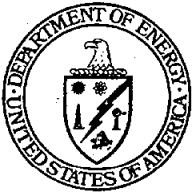

Dear Mr. Fede:

Thank you for your letter of December 19, 1994, in which you expressed your concern with the yellow-colored drums being stored on various properties in the vicinity of the Maywood Interim Storage Site.

We have investigated your concern and can assure you that the drums are not associated with any activities being conducted by the Department of Energy. Based on discussions with Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) - Region II staff, it appears that the drums are the result of remedial investigation activities conducted on behalf of the Stepan Company.

It is our understanding that the EPA has initiated actions to specifically address your concerns. Those actions will presumably be addressed in the EPA's response to your letter.
