Re: Maywood Thorium Contamination

The Department is in receipt of your October 15, 1995 facsimile correspondence to Assistant Commissioner Gimello and I have been asked to respond to same. As has been indicated in numerous previous response letters, N.J.S.A 58:10B et. seq. (commonly referred to as S-1070) requires the establishment of both residential and nonresidential cleanup criteria for those New Jersey properties involved in environmental remediation activities. This statute is the basis and continues to be the focus of discussions with the United States Department of Energy (USDOE) concerning acceptable New Jersey cleanup criteria. As we have discussed previously, acceptable cleanup criteria must provide for the protection of human health and the environment in satisfaction of requirements set forth in N.J.S.A 58:10B et. seq. This is core to the mission of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP). Finally, as I have relayed to you in the past, the NJDEP will fulfill its statutory mandate.
